Nevis is a remarkable island jewel nestled in the northern end of the Lesser Antilles, among the crystal-clear water of the Caribbean Sea. With more than 3 miles of golden sand fringed with palm trees and clear turquoise waters, Pinney's Beach is a stretch of classic Caribbean coastline just outside Charlestown on the island of Nevis.

For the residence, we aim to reflect Pinneys Beach's landscape by using natural materials and clean lines. This design will create a comfortable retreat that harmonizes with Four Seasons brand guidelines.










CONCEPT SCHEME ENTRANCE HALLWAY












MASTER BATHROOM







STYLESCAPE

N O . 1

The ceiling design will feature exposed beams in the entrance.

N O . 2

Marmorino plaster will be applied throughout the space to introduce subtle texture and depth to the walls.

NO.3

Stone will be used throughout the space—whether as flooring or wall accents to create a seamless blend between indoor and outdoor areas.

N O . 4


Joinery Details - Bespoke joinery doors crafted with timber frames and detailed with seagrass inserts for a natural, textured finish.

NO.5

Timber joinery brings warmth and texture, combined with a Travertine work top creating a subtle, balanced detail.

N O . 6

Timber Flooring will be installed in all bedrooms and staircase, bringing warmth and a natural touch to the space.


